Department of Computer Science

To identify slow and advanced learners, our department conducted an entry level test and a personal interview for each batch of students and assesses their learning levels by considering three parameters - marks in the entry level test and the performance in the interview.

Slow learners were encouraged by

The Teachers Act as Mentors - Each member of the faculty is assigned mentorship of a fixed number of students from each class – UG and PG – to attend to their emotional well-being. Special Classes - Special classes and Remedial classes are engaged on Saturdays and on some other holidays in addition to those taught during off hours on working days.

Grouping of Students - Grouping of students in such a way that every student has an advanced learner to help the slow learners to cope up with the subject

Special attention to NSS/NCC students and who lose classes due to medical reasons

Study materials pertaining to the days absent are provided to both sports students and medical absentees, special classes on request are taken and peer assistance is provided

Question Paper Discussion- Students were revised with the previous question papers so that they get familiarised with the questions on each module of each subject.
