#### **COLLEGE LIBRARY**

The college has a well equipped computerized digital library, which holds a stock of 58,523 volumes, 974 bound back volumes of journals, 555 maps & audio-video collections and 125 volumes of Xerox copies. It subscribes 102 journals & periodicals and 8 dailies. E-resources (E-Books & E. Journals) are also available.

The general library functions on all college working days from 9 am to 4.30 pm. The reading room will be open from 9 am to 5 pm on all days, except public holidays.

#### **Text Book library**

A Text Book Library or Book Bank is functioning on the grants from the UGC, maintaining itself as a separate section of the College Library.

#### **Departmental Libraries**

Every department of the college has a subject oriented sectional library. The Head of the Department is in charge of the stock, issue and return of books.

#### INTERNAL EXAMINATIONS




