

## REPORT

### **Voluntary blood donation camp 2020-21.**

During the COVID-19 outbreak, there was a drastic reduction in the total number of voluntary blood donors visiting blood banks, cancellation of Voluntary blood camps, etc. It was a risk and challenge to arrange a voluntary blood donation camp during this period. As the lockdown ceased and the situation was a little better we arranged a voluntary blood donation camp at IQARA hospital in association with the Blood donation forum on October 2/2021. We followed the guidelines issued by National Blood Transfusion Council, Ministry of Health, and Family Welfare on 25<sup>th</sup> March 2020 to Blood Transfusion services to collect blood in view of the COVID-19 pandemic. About 100 units were donated during the camp. The department of zoology donated 7 units of blood.
