- **Department of Mathematics and Statistics** will assign one of its faculties as the Class Coordinator for the smooth conducting of the training program.

- **Department of Mathematics and Statistics** shall assist in the registration and participation of students in the JAM examination.

E. FEE: The fee for this training program is INR 60,000/- per batch of 20 students or less. If there are more than 20 students each student will pay INR 3000/-.

F. PAYMENT:

The fee is to be paid by the students directly to **MathLab**

The students shall directly remit the full fee directly to **MathLab** using appropriate online transfer mode.

The Course Coordinator of **Department of Mathematics and Statistics** shall liaise with the designated official of **MathLab** in facilitating the remittance of the fee by the students directly to **MathLab** using online transfer mode. The payment is to be completed by all the students before the commencement of the training.

G. REGISTRATION FOR THE PROGRAM: The Class Coordinator shall work closely with the **MathLab** officials to complete all work related to the registration of the students for the program including the payment of the fees.

H. THE SCHEDULE: The schedule for the classes, practice tests and doubt clearing sessions, etc., and their timing shall be mutually decided by **MathLab** and **Department of Mathematics and Statistics** taking into consideration of the student's regular class timings, university examinations etc.

I. CONDUCTING OF THE CLASSES: The online classes for the modules shall be delivered through YouTube /ZOOM/ GOOGLE MEET / WEBEX / JIOMEET or any other suitable online seminar delivery software. The students should have the option to watch the video classes multiple times at their own convenience.

J. EXCLUSIVE SESSIONS: The sessions for Department of Mathematics and Statistics students to be exclusive and there won't be any grouping together with the students of other colleges.

K. TERM: Terms of this MoU shall be for one years commencing on the **01 of JUNE 2021**. The MoU can be renewed for a further period of one year on terms agreed by the parties at that time. The videos of the classes will no longer be available once the student completes her UG course at Department of Mathematics and Statistics.

L. TERMINATION: This MOU may be terminated by either party by notice in writing from the party not at fault if the other party is in breach of this MoU and fails to remedy the breach within thirty (30) days from receipt of notice in writing from the first party specifying the breach.

M. CONFIDENTIALITY OF INFORMATION: The parties herewith undertake to treat confidentially all information that they obtain directly or indirectly from each other within the framework of the student mobilization and training engagement. Confidential treatment means that the information obtained may not be made available to a third party and that the information may not be used for the parties' economic purposes or for the purposes of a third party. The parties undertake to use the information obtained solely for the purpose stipulated in this MOU. Any use going beyond that purpose or the conveying of information to a third party requires the written consent of both parties.

N. FORCE MAJEURE: Non-performance of either party (except for payment obligations) shall be excused to the extent that performance is rendered impossible by pandemics, strike, fire, flood, war, terrorism, act of God, government acts or orders or restrictions, failure of suppliers, or any other reason where failure to perform is beyond the control and not caused by the negligence of the non-performing party.

O. NON-COMPETE and NON- POACH: MathLab and Department of Mathematics and Statistics and its employees should not propose any potential project directly with the client(s)/ students for whom work is undertaken as part of this MoU with out the formal and written consent of the other party.



Q. ALTERATION: Alterations and supplements to this MOU must be made in writing to hold validity.

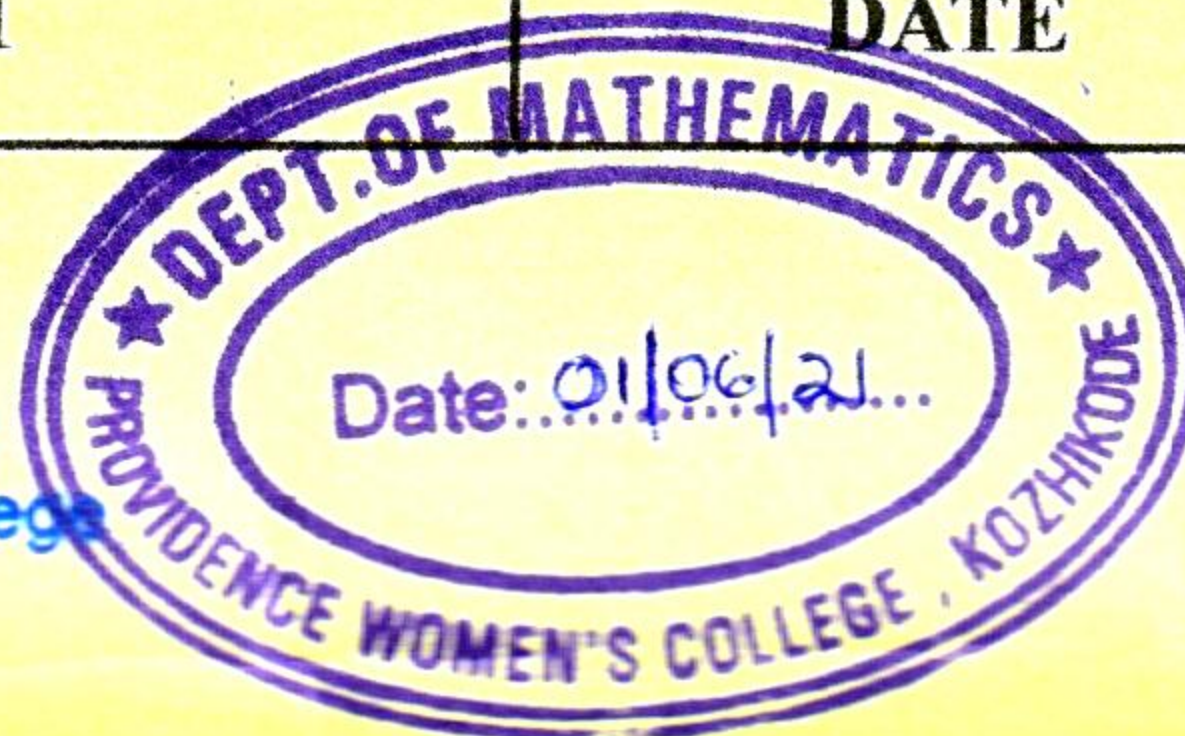
