



.Christmas was also celebrated virtually. The celebrations included a rhythmic performance from the students. As part of Christmas various competitions were organized.


September: YANAM2020 –World Tourism Day Celebration

Diary of Events:

1. **19 June 2020: Reading Day observed with an online debate on the topic “Traditional Reading vs. E-Reading”.**

Participants: 19 Students of II MA English.

The academic year began in a Work from Home mode, with the Covid 19 pandemic forcing all activities to adapt to the new normal. Apart from classes being conducted in the online mode, the reading and reference patterns also underwent significant change. How do the students cope with e-books? This prompted the debate, where students expressed their preference for traditional reading, and willingness for e-reading.

1. **15 January 2021: Prof. Radha S. Nair Annual Debate Competition.**

Topic: Living Life Online: The Impact of the Pandemic on Students - Pros and Cons

Participants: 18 students representing 9 departments of the college

Judging Panel: Dr. Prathibha P K, Dr. Jyolsna B., faculty, English department.

Winner of the Best Debater Title: Ms. Sona K.S., II B.Sc. Chemistry.

The annual debate was conducted online for the first time, and drew enthusiastic participation from the students of various departments. Students voiced their views based on their own experience of online classes and stay-at-home. The discussions also analysed the impact of the pandemic on the economy, health, and environment, and they way the changes in these areas affected student life. The thrust of the debate veered towards the gender issue, and the consensus arrived at was that if the pandemic affected millions adversely, the worst hit among those millions are the vulnerable groups of women, the economically backward and the migrants.

1. **25 January 2021: Online Debate on the topic: Are Nehru’s Views on Culture Relevant Today?**

Participants: 24 students of I Year MA English

This was an activity intended as an innovative method of teaching and learning through debates. The students were divided into two groups to argue for and against the views expressed by the first Prime Minister of the country on Culture. The debate was based on the prescribed text “What is Culture” - a speech delivered by Pt. Nehru at the inauguration of the

Indian Council for Cultural Relations in New Delhi on 9 April 1950). The students pointed out that Nehru's views on culture may appear as too idealistic, but there is no denying the fact that his transnational and agnostic views on culture can in fact be the direction that many of the global problems could take in the quest for a resolution.

On 19 June 2020, Bookscape, the Readers' Club of PWC launched an online community for readers named e-Bookscape on national readers' day by making use of WhatsApp as the digital platform. A contest on the theme "Write a letter to your favourite fictional character" was held on the same day.

On 26th June, the Club celebrated the 50th anniversary of the annual LGBTQ+ Pride traditions by mentioning various recommendations from the queer genre, where books like *Middle Sex*, *The Boyfriend*, *So now you know-growing up gay in India*, *Carry on*, *Oranges are not the only fruit*, *The Passion*, *Lihaaf*, *Simon Vs the Sapiens*, *The Ministry of Utmost Happiness* etc.. were introduced to the members.

On July 15, the 26th death anniversary of Vaikom Muhammad Basheer was observed by sharing various works written by the author.

On July 16, a discussion was held, based on *To Kill a Mockingbird* by Harper Lee as the day marked the 60th anniversary of the publication of the novel.

From July 13-July 19, a series of genres and books was introduced to the community, which included books across genres like detective stories, fantasy/magical realism, horror, romantic comedy, science fiction, historical fiction/Samurai fiction and dystopian fiction.

From 20 July to 2 August, a podcast series, "The Short Story Express", was conducted, which included various short stories across genres in audio format narrated by 16 students of III BA English: Aysha Nilufar, Athulya Roy, Arunima Anil, Anjali Soman, Greeshma Antony, Anagha PM, Hanan Ashraf, Gayathri Muraleedharan, Shahda Sadiq, Devika S Praveen, Vedalakshmi MR, Rahiya K, Jain Ann Joseph, Aswathi BS, Jenny Johnson and Aysha Mishkath.

On 12 December, the activities of Bookscape for the winter semester were flagged off with a series of reading-based activities, in which students recommended their books by their favourite authors, including Haruki Murakami, Ruskin Bond, Dan Brown, Carmen Maria Machado, Madhavikutty, Ottessa Moshfegh, Neil Gaiman, Khaled Hosseini, JK Rowling, Chimamanda Adichie, Manoj Kurur, Nicholas Sparks, Alice Walker, Aravind Adiga, Andre Aciman, Mo Xiang Tong Xiu, Leigh Bardugo, and David Baldacci.

From 10 Jan 2021 to 15 Jan 2021, the Club conducted "Telltale of Dragons, Samurai, Muay and Hanbok", a series of recommendations of East Asian fiction, including the Chinese novel Mo Dau Zu Shi by Mo Xiang Tong Xiu, the Japanese manga Kamisama Hajimemashita by Julietta Suzuki, the Thai novels Because We are Together by JittiRain and Tharntype's Story by Orawan Vichayawannakul, and the Korean webtoon "True Beauty". Recommendations were prepared by Gayathri Muraleedharan, Dona Mariya Thomas, and Kavya Rajesh of III BA English.

On 20 Feb 2021, there was a discussion of influential women authors in the history of English literature, including Maya Angelou, JK Rowling, Alice Walker, SE Hinton, Agatha Christie, Laura Ingalls Wilder, Harper Lee, Jane Austen, Emily Dickinson, Louisa May Alcott, Mary Shelley, George Eliot, Emily Bronte, Charlotte Bronte, Virginia Woolf, Harriet Beecher Stowe, Ayn Rand, Margaret Mitchell, Edith Wharton, and Zora Neale Hurston.

In March 2021, Bookscape celebrated the International Women's History Month by honouring powerful women writers, their works, and female characters in literature through a series of videos prepared by students, released on the official YouTube channel of the Department of English, under the title "Choose to Challenge." AUGUST

The month of August had the best classical movies of the week posted by Greeshma Antony of 3rd English, including Pather Panchali,Snow White,Seven Samurai,Where is my friend’s home? and Cinema Paradiso. The recent release Shankuntala Devi was chosen by Hanan Ashraf of 3rd English as the movie of the month. Panel discussion on the same is scheduled on 30th August 2020.

SEPTEMBER

The month of September witnessed the new ventures - Docudrama day and Cliffhangers spring into being. Cliffhangers focussed on posting gripping , sensational movies every week. Docudrama day observed once the month involved posting movies based on real stories and events. The venture was introduced by Nayana Alphonsa and Mufeeda of II PG. Anvita Dutt’s strikingly feminist paranormal fable ‘ Bulbulla’ was chosen as the movie the month by Nayanthara Thilak of 2nd English. The month of November was marked by an exciting panel discussion on the movie ‘Bulbulla’. The objective of the discussion was to decode the different shades that make up a woman by analyzing the character of Bulbulla. The discussion was scheduled on the 7th of November from 7 p.m. to 8 p.m. The discussion got so lively and animated that our panelists

crossed the 1 hour mark to a whooping 2 ½ hours. The moderator was Nayanthara Tilak of 2nd English and the panelists included Nandana Jayaprakash, Sandra Ajith and Chitrangatha of 2nd English. The sessions were handled by Rahiba T of 4th sem M.Com. Rahiba T is an virtual entrepreneur having four years' experience in craft making.




Participant's Profile:







Preamble:

The consumer movement marks 15th March with World Consumer Rights Day every year, as a means of raising global awareness about consumer rights and needs. Celebrating the day is a chance to demand that the rights of all consumers are respected and protected, and to protest against market abuses and social injustices which undermine those rights. Consumer goods are products bought for consumption by the average consumer. Alternatively called final goods, consumer goods are the end result of production and manufacturing and are what a consumer will see stocked on the store shelf. Clothing, food, and jewellery are all examples of consumer goods. Basic or raw materials, such as copper, are not considered consumer goods because they must be transformed into usable products. Consumer goods are also called final goods, or end products, because they are the ultimate output of a productive process that occurs over time. Entrepreneurs and businesses combine capital goods (such as machinery in a factory), labour from workers, and raw materials (such as land and basic metals), to produce consumer goods for sale. Goods that are used in these production processes, but not themselves sold to consumers are known as producer goods. Convenience goods are those that are regularly consumed and are readily available for purchase. These goods are mostly sold by wholesalers and retailers and include items such as milk and tobacco products. Convenience goods can be further segmented into staple convenience goods (fulfilling basic customer necessities) and impulse convenience goods (non-priority goods, such as cigarettes).

PROGRAMME SCHEDULE & INSTRUCTIONS

Day 1: Make a wild flower bouquet

1. The bouquet should be made with fresh flowers/ leaves of wild plants only.
2. Ornamental/ garden plants cannot be used.
3. No plastic or artificial materials (including wrappers, strings, beads or any decorations) should be used.
4. Natural fibres, twigs etc. can be used for adding beauty.
5. A clear close-up image of the bouquet should be sent.
6. Take another similar image with your institution id card kept along with it. Five short listed entries need to submit this photograph when asked. Those who fail to do so will be disqualified.

Day 2: Biodiversity Photography

1. All photographs need to be watermarked with the name or initials of the photographer, preferably at the corners of bottom part, without affecting the clarity of the image.
2. No special effects should be applied on the photograph. The photograph must be in its original state and cannot be altered in any way (removing, adding, reversing, or distorting subjects within the frame is not allowed).
3. If mobile phones are used, no beautification apps should be used.
4. Photographs should depict the theme Biodiversity (both flora and fauna can be represented)
5. The decision of the photography judging panel will be final.

Day 3: Poster Making

1. Posters should be handmade.
2. Posters should be based on the theme 'Our solutions are in nature', the theme of the International Day for Biological Diversity (IDB) 2020.
3. There are no size restrictions.
4. Write your name and name of the institution on the poster at the lower right corner.
5. Send a clear vertical photograph (taken with the camera axis directed towards the poster as vertically as possible). Kindly avoid oblique photographs.
6. Contestants can submit only one poster. If more than one image is there, the first one only will be considered.

Day 4: An Interesting Plant

1. Take photograph of any one plant from your surroundings that have some interesting features.
2. Describe its curious aspects in one or two sentences. It can be regarding its appearance/ special properties / special responses / any other.
3. Descriptions can be either in English or Malayalam.
4. Description can be given as caption (below the photograph) while you post the image in the group.
5. One contestant can post only one photograph only.

Day 5: Prepare a Dish with a Leafy Vegetable

1. Any locally grown leafy vegetable can be used.
2. It can be a cooked or uncooked item. The leafy vegetable should be the major ingredient of the dish.
3. Take a clear photograph of the dish prepared, along with your id card kept beside it.
4. Give the name of the dish and the list of major ingredients as caption along with the photograph.
5. As judgment is not possible by observing the photograph only, all those who post photos as directed, will be getting an e-certificate

Day 6: Dry Floral Arrangement

1. Any locally available dried plant materials (dried flowers, leaves, twigs, fruits, bark, nutshells etc.) can be used.
2. Only natural materials can be used.
3. No fresh flowers, leaves, twigs etc. should be used.
4. Any style can be adopted for the arrangement.
5. Paper, Plastic, metal or any other artificial materials should not be used.
6. A clear close-up image of the floral arrangement should be sent.
7. Take another similar image with your institution id card kept along with it. Five short listed entries need to submit this photograph when asked. Those who fail to do so will be disqualified.
8. Judgment will be based on overall beauty, style, creativity, uniqueness etc.

Day 7: Make your Microgreens

1. Do the initial works for the preparation of microgreens (Challenge for Day 7) today itself, as it requires 7 days of growth period.
2. Get your seeds ready, it can be some pulses, seed spices, or any seed of your choice, that can produce palatable microgreens.
3. The growth medium can be paper, cloth etc. It will be better if you avoid soil, as this is gaining popularity as a soilless cultivation technique.
4. Take pictures of different stages of growth from Day 1 to Day 7 and make a collage. Keep a separate clear picture of the growth on Day 7. (instructions for Day 7 up to this was given on Day 1)
5. Photographs need to be posted on Day 7 only. Take a photograph of the microgreens prepared as per instructions given on Day 1.

Day 8:

1. Art work can be done using any fresh or dried plant part (leaf, flower etc)
2. The material as such has to be used. No painting/ colouring should be done.
3. Original shape of material has to be retained. Other shapes cannot be cutout of it.
4. Pencil shavings or any such items cannot be used.
5. The entire design has to be completed with plant materials only. Drawings/ lines etc. cannot be used to connect parts or to complete the design.
6. Take a clear image and send for evaluation.
7. Contestants can send only one photograph.
8. Evaluation will be based on creativity, overall beauty, novelty etc.

Day 9

1. Attempt the quiz on biodiversity and environment using the given link..
2. The quiz is restricted for students only.
3. There is a time limit of 25 minutes to attempt 40 questions..
4. All those who gain more than 70 % marks will be getting an e certificate.

Day 10:

1. Prepare your kokedama.(moss ball) with any plant of your choice.
2. Take a photograph and post in the group.
3. Evaluation will be based on the perfection of your kokedama.
