- 'Pothichoru', a pack of meals- for needy people











Industry, Innovation And Infrastructure

Started a book collection drive in collaboration with Kites foundation, an NGO. Received 150 books which was donated to the book farm officials on 17 September 2021










Sustainable Cities And Communities




