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## 1. Constitutional Rights and Values


#### **PARVAAZ**

#### **LIBERTA**





## PROMINENT FEMALE FREEDOM FIGHTERS





#### BHARAT KA AMRIT MAHOTSAV






## **Knowing The Indian Constitution**


## How far is India Independent Even after Getting Freedom



#### VIRTUAL PLEDGE
























## **PEN IT DOWN**





#### VANDE MATARAM





### THE ROLE OF PATRIOTISM IN SHAPING ONE'S FUTURE






#### FANCY DRESS COMPETITION ON REPUBLIC DAY






#### **CAMPUS POLITICS**







#### **CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS**







#### THE PATH OF PEACE: SAY NO TO WAR






