

Feedback from Alumni

The feedback from alumni was analysed and it was observed that majority of the alumni (approximately 90%) expressed satisfaction with their overall college experience, citing the supportive faculty, quality education, and a vibrant campus life.

The alumni feedback sought to evaluate the effectiveness of the syllabus and curriculum in fostering academic enrichment, providing experiential learning, and aiding preparation for competitive examinations and the **strengths of the institution highlighted were;**

- **Academic Excellence:** Alumni appreciated the structure of the syllabus, comprehensive curriculum and the dedication of faculty members, resulting in significant contribution to their academic enrichment. While some respondents identified areas for improvement, only a few expressed isolated concerns, indicating the overall contentment and also absence of widespread issues
- **Skill Development:** Many highlighted the development of critical thinking, communication skills, and teamwork during their studies, and the opportunities to hone their skill sets.
- **Networking Opportunities:** Alumni valued the connections they made with peers, professors, and industry professionals through events and activities, they were motivated to participate in.
- **Value-based education system:** The feedback indicated the institution's value based education system leading to empowered students, equipping them to adapt to life's challenges while also gathering suggestions for improvement. Alumni recognized its alignment with real-life challenges and its role in shaping well-rounded individuals.
- **Experiential learning opportunities :** most alumni found the syllabus exemplary in offering practical, real-world applications. However, a subset of respondents provided moderate ratings, suggesting opportunities to further enhance the experiential components.
- **Student Progression :** Many alumni have successfully transitioned to higher education programs such as ACCA, CMA, and master's degrees, reflecting the solid academic foundation laid by the curriculum and its effectiveness in preparing them for advanced studies.

The feedback also made few suggestions, like;

- **Enhancing Internship Opportunities:** Alumni emphasized the importance of internships in bridging the gap between academics and the workforce required by the industry.
- **Lifelong Learning:** They suggested offering continued education, certification programs, and workshops, while opening up continuous learning opportunities for alumni, too.
- **Stronger Alumni Network:** Members also expressed interest and willingness in participating in mentorship programs, networking events, and collaborative projects.

The feedback underscored the institution's commitment to providing a well-rounded education while also identifying areas where enhancements could elevate the learning experience further.
