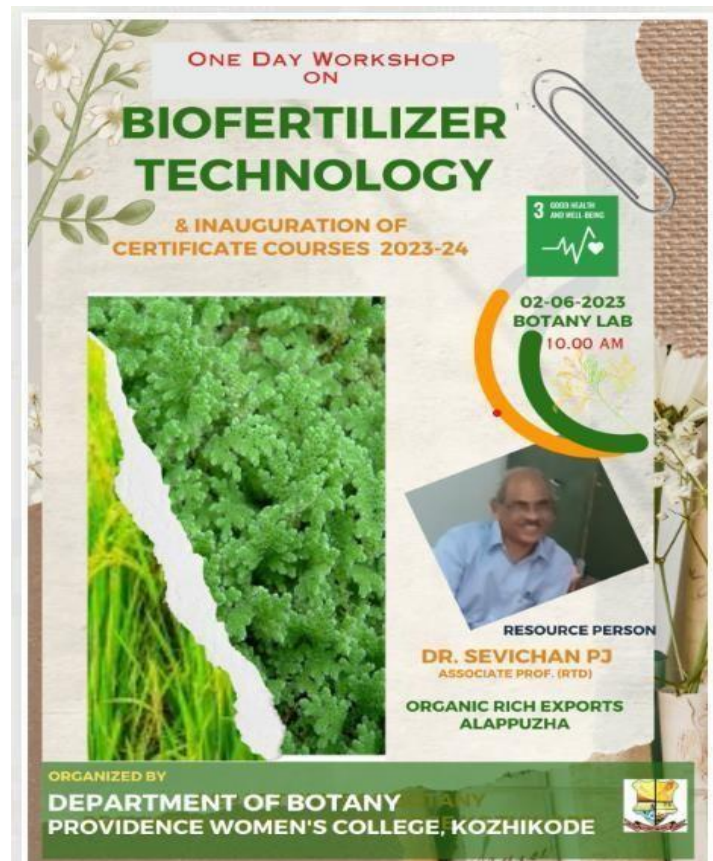

The Department of Botany, in association with Organic Rich Exports, Alappuzha, organized a one-day workshop on "Biofertilizer Technology" on 6 June 2023. The workshop featured Dr. Sevichen P. J., a distinguished Retired professor from the Department of Botany, St. Joseph's College, Devagiri, Calicut. With years of academic and research experience, Dr. Sevichen aimed to promote awareness and provide in-depth knowledge about biofertilizers, their significance in sustainable agriculture, the biofertilizer production from Azolla, coconut husk and other organic substances and also gave a detailed account on the application of biofertilizers for enhancing soil fertility and crop yield.

Objective of the workshop

1. Provide hands-on training on the preparation and application of biofertilizers.
2. To encourage the students and women to adopt biofertilizer technology, thereby enhancing their role in agriculture and rural entrepreneurship.
