THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU) is executed at PROVIDENCE WOMEN'S COLLEGE, KOZHIKODE, KERALA on 04.03.2024 by and between SERAH ZINES LLP, a startup which promotes science education and an incorporated under section 12(1) of the Limited Liability Partnership Act having its registered office at Sreeragam (H), Naduvannur PO, Kozhikode, Kerala - 673614 and represented by its director and founder Ms. Kavya C S, hereinafter referred as 'SERAH' (which expression shall, where the context so admits, mean and include its successors, representatives and permitted assigns) of the One part; and PROVIDENCE WOMEN'S COLLEGE, KOZHIKODE an institute/college aided by the Govt of Kerala and affiliated to Calicut University, having its registered office at Malaparamba, Calicut - 673009, Kerala hereinafter referred

to as 'PROVIDENCE WOMEN'S COLLEGE,' (which expression shall, where the context so admits, mean and include its successors, representatives and permitted assigns) of the Other party (hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Parties" and individually as "the Party") WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:-

WHEREAS, 'SERAH' being a platform for teaching, research and promoting science education and communication has well qualified and professional resource persons as faculties, mentors and well wishers and whereas **SERAH** with its resources and networking facilitates higher education for undergraduates and postgraduates, science education research leading to publication, R&D activities and outreach and career guidance services **AND WHEREAS 'PROVIDENCE WOMEN'S COLLEGE'** a pioneer institute in Kerala, for education and research of high standards.

AND WHEREAS both entities work to enhance the quality of teaching and learning process, research, and extension of services to the society at large, and both **SERAH and PROVIDENCE WOMEN'S COLLEGE** are convinced about the mutual benefit of forging formal linkage to develop collaborating outreach and research programs in core competence areas with a special focus on science education.

NOW, therefore, considering the premises and mutual covenants hereinafter contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:


1. Objective of the collaboration

- a) To collaborate and cooperate with each other to enhance the quality of teaching, training, and research activities.
- b) To provide the infrastructure facility for SERAH to set up the outreach center at PROVIDENCE WOMEN'S COLLEGE for not less than one year.
- c) To provide access to SERAH to use the expertise and facilities at PROVIDENCE WOMEN'S COLLEGE and offer seminars/workshops and conferences.
- d) To grant permission to SERAH to work jointly or independently at the outreach center at PROVIDENCE WOMEN'S COLLEGE under a mutually agreed framework.
- e) To support the exchange of academic and training material, including access to the library and other digital resources of PROVIDENCE WOMEN'S COLLEGE.
- f) To encourage any other activities that both institutions agree to be of mutual benefit.

2. Responsibilities/Deliverables from PROVIDENCE WOMEN'S COLLEGE

- a) Shall make available the IT infrastructure and internet connectivity required to conduct the academic training programs.
- b) Shall provide all the support services to SERAH during the conduct of the academic programs.

3. Responsibilities/Deliverables from SERAH

- a) SERAH will arrange the resources person for the conduct of academic programs and any remuneration in that respect will be taken care.
- b) SERAH is liable to maintain a rigorous report of the activities conducted on a daily basis. A report along with the details of the programs conducted, resources person(s), list of participants along with photograph is to be handed over to PROVIDENCE WOMEN'S COLLEGE at the end of each program.

4. Confidentiality

Both parties hereunder agree that any information disclosed by one party to the other while carrying out collaborative activities under MoU shall be maintained as confidential and shall not disclose to any third party without the prior written consent of the other party.

5. Intellectual property rights (IPR) protection

SERAH retains all the intellectual property rights in its outreach activity center. Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as granting any license or right to the College to use, modify, or distribute the platform or any of its components. SERAH shall decide the extent of ownership depending upon the relative level of input made by the parties. The above principles will apply to all the activities of IPR, such as patenting, technology transfer, and commercialization of innovations developed out of the activities covered under this MoU.

6. Financial Commitment

This MoU, being a cooperative and collaborative understanding for academic excellence and enhancement of quality of higher education, the activities will be done in sustainable mode. The registration fees for the academic programs organised at PROVIDENCE WOMEN'S COLLEGE will be mutually agreed upon. SERAH will avail 80% of the income generated from outreach activities conducted for external participants (such as workshops, skill development courses, Faculty Development Programs etc.). PROVIDENCE WOMEN'S COLLEGE holds the right to retain 20% share of the income generated by such activities conducted at the college by SERAH for its infrastructural development.

7. Term and Termination

This MoU will be in force for one year from the date of signing of the same and thereafter may be renewed subject to such other terms and conditions as mutually agreed upon. This MoU may be terminated by either party on mutual agreement by issuing three months' notice in writing to the other party prior to the desired termination date. However, both parties agree that all the obligations are fully met before the notice of termination.

8. Miscellaneous

No modification to this MoU shall be binding unless it is made in writing and signed by both parties. Each of the parties hereto agrees to comply with all laws applicable to the party concerned regarding


the activities undertaken in pursuance of this MoU.

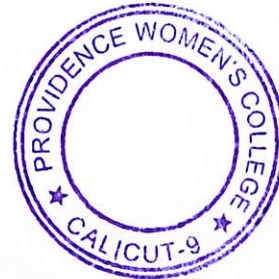
