



- A university canteen weighing student's food waste to highlight responsible portion sizes
- A student-run gardening club on campus planning to collect acorns and create a nursery of saplings *
- Clean-up actions and celebration of zero emissions day with promotion of biogas and electric vehicles -

We have a couple of requests for the next few weeks as we build up the NPU Student Ambassador scheme. As our first cohort, we'd love to have your input in shaping our






COLLABORATORS MARKED ON THE GLOBAL MAP




FACULTY PARTICIPATION AT THE GLOBAL SUMMIT, JULY 2022
