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# Sahayog: Peer Teaching / Pair - Share

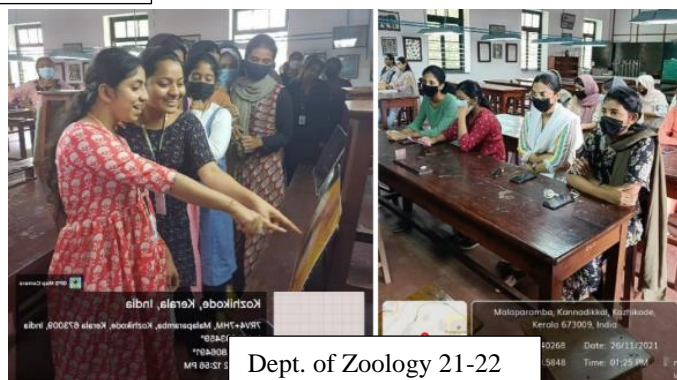

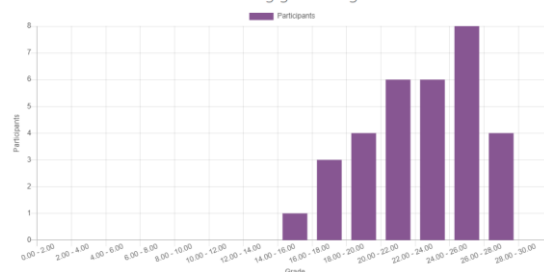

**OTHELLO** 

In the early half of the 16<sup>th</sup> century, born to a well off family, along the coast of north western Africa, Othello grows up enjoying a dignified childhood. His father was a leading army official under the African Berber dynasty and he was well protected as a child.

But unfortunately during the Turkish invasions of the northern coast of Africa, the young Othello is taken up as a slave for the Ottoman empire. From then and there, his life takes a rough turn, and he unwillingly embarks on a journey he doesn't know will one day define his entire existence.

The Ottoman empire had an elaborate army setup, where they took in slaves from all around the globe, during their exploits worldwide and trained them under strict supervision to produce a massive army loyal only to the sultan. Slowly, yet steadily, He rose in rank. His colour, his ethnicity, his exotic otherness, his differences. None of them could hide his majestic aura and his prodigious talent. He rose to the pinnacle of fame and power, and gained respect across the kingdom.


