56 faculty members of the teaching staff attended the programme. The workshop created awareness and understanding of the user friendly digital tools that could be incorporated into Teaching Learning.



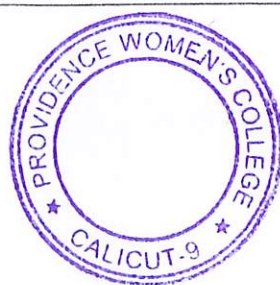
