An awareness class about Menstrual problems in adolescents and menstrual hygeine was conducted in the college




### 2.2 Night Walk

### **3.1 Vending Machine Inauguration**





### 4.1 Gender in Translation







#### **6.1 Gender Norms**








Dublin,Ireland. It was held on 7 March2022. students got an insight about the







### 7.2 Being a Trans isn't a Choice






### 7.4 Pride Month Celebrations: "My Journey"
