1. Water Sanitation Movements


As a part of International Day for Water, the PG students of the Department of Botany in association in **River Protection Council**, visited 'Green World' conserved area in the banks of **Punoor River, Kakkodi**, on 22nd March, 2022, where they participated in water sanitation programme and attended awareness lecture on the 'Importance of conserving Natural Water Reservoirs' by popular activists including Dr. Shobheendran. Students actively participated in the public discussion delivering their ideas to protect and nurture the natural water bodies and ensure clean drinking water for all.



Cadets on Action: On June 5th as a part of world Environment Day Celebration various activities were organized by 3rd year NCC cadets in Co-operation with Nadhi Samrakshana Samidhi, Sri. Satheesh Babu Kollambalathu delivered a talk on the Importance of protecting water bodies at CP Koya's Residence. The cadets cleaned the surroundings of Punoor river near Malikkadavu. 28 cadets actively participated in the program.



Mambuzha Water Project: 9K Girls BN NCC cadets of the College conducted a survey on 10.05.2022, near Mambuzha river to analyse the source of pollutants contaminating river. The Cadet team the accompanied the Panchayat President, Panchayat Member and community development other volunteers. The main sources of pollution identified are dumping of household organic as well as plastic wastes that restrict the natural flow of river. The programme aimed to clean the river and spread awareness among the residents which could protect the river and make the water in to potable form.




