The Covid - 19 pandemic had affected people all over the world mentally, physically, socially and economically. Students of all age groups were the primary victims for this especially the lower grades. Their IQ and EQ levels drastically subsided as online classes were not as effective as the usual face to face classes. To analyze this situation, 43 2^{nd} year B. Sc Mathematics students seeked the help of parents of the students of AMLP Parambil Bazar School.

Objectives:

- To understand whether Covid 19 pandemic has affected the IQ levels of lower grade students.
- To analyze the percentage affected by the pandemic.
- To develop and improve the thinking and interacting capacities of the both School and College students.

Methodology:-

The 43 students were divided into 3 groups and each group prepared IQ tests for Grade 1, Grade 2 and Grade 3 children of the School. With the help of the school authorities they collected the phone numbers of the parents of these children. Limitations;-

- The Project was restricted to one School.
- Some of the parents might have helped out their wards to answer the IQ tests due to less response from their child.

Outcomes:-

- The Project gave an understanding on how badly the pandemic has affected both college and school students.
- The 2nd year B. Sc Mathematics students had to become more socially committed to do this project.
- It inculcated a thought to help out all the pandemic affected population.






